WYATT ROY AN “OUTSTANDING CANDIDATE” FOR THE LNP

Liberal Patron Senator for Longman, Senator Sue Boyce, today defended the party's 20 year old candidate, Mr Wyatt Roy.

"Wyatt Roy is doing a fantastic job of garnering support from all sectors of the community," Senator Boyce said.

"Anonymous and malicious criticisms of Mr Roy such as those in The Australian today suggest that the Labor Party is getting seriously worried."

Senator Boyce said Wyatt had been supported overwhelmingly at his pre-selection by local party members.

"As Patron Senator for Longman, I attended that preselection and like the huge majority of those party delegates, I was very impressed with his maturity, commitment and grasp of the issues," she said.

Senator Boyce said the promise shown by Mr Roy at the pre-selection had been more than borne out since.

Senator Boyce said it was particularly pleasing the response Wyatt Roy was getting from older electors.
